2017

In 2017, a team of four retention specialists conducted in-plant outreach visits to **485** manufacturing and manufacturing-related firms in the City of Cleveland. Those firms represented **19,759 jobs**. CIRI identified **597 opportunities** to provide valuable services to manufacturers in a variety of industries, from additive manufacturing to distribution. CIRI completed **382 services** primarily in the areas of safety & security, employment & training, infrastructure, and business operations. CIRI engaged partners including the **City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Accelerate Cleveland Manufacturing (ACM), and Towards Employment.**

Braden Sutphin Ink Company centralizes its business around two important assets: their employees, and the American printer. Thanks in part to WIRE-Net's CIRI program, which has provided outreach and services to the company for years, Braden Sutphin continues to expand and foster the teamwork that makes their company unique.

With more than 100 years of operating experience, Braden Sutphin is an ink company in the true American tradition. Service-oriented, the company ships 95 percent of its orders within 3 days of being received and takes extensive measures to ensure batch-to-batch consistency. In addition, its research and development has allowed it to expand its ink portfolio to include sheetfed, offset, web heatset, non-heatset, and other varieties of ink.

Since 1999, the CIRI program has been providing services to Braden Sutphin to keep its operation moving. After their annual outreach assessment, the company's CIRI Industrial

Development Manager introduced them to the City of Cleveland Department of Economic Development. This partnership, and the resources connected to it, enabled Braden Sutphin to complete its facility expansion and improvements at their 3650 E 93rd St facility, consolidating production, lab, and R&D in one central location. Because of this intervention, the company was able to retain \$2M in sales and create 2 new jobs in the City of Cleveland. The company's investment in plant and equipment costs increased by \$65K, and its investment in workforce skills increased by \$25K.

Foote Printing

Foote Printing has provided exemplary design and printing services for decades, and is still family owned. Taking advantage of WIRE-Net's CIRI program, the company has been able to invest more in their employees and maintain a solid trajectory of growth.

Foote Printing is a family-owned, union, commercial print shop that's been around since 1907. With services that range from graphic design to printing and mailing, the company serves local municipalities, design companies, and both small copy shops and large corporations. Foote Printing also prides itself on being earth-conscious, investing in solar panels, recycling nearly all of their paper waste, and relying on LED lighting to reduce energy consumption.

For the past 10 years, the CIRI program has been regularly checking in with Foote Printing to offer services and support for its business goals. Over the years, CIRI has helped the company get more customers, expand to more marketing channels, connect with other business owners, and produce more specialty products. Foote Printing has been able invest \$210K in its plant, with additional investments in workforce practices and employee skills of between \$200-300K. On top of that, Foote Printing has seen an increase in sales of 5 percent, and has been able to retain 12 jobs.
